Who:

Boy Scouts who are First Class and above, who desire to become leaders through service as Cub Scout or Webelos Scout Den Chiefs. A Den Chief should be two to four years older than those he will be leading.

Any boy may attend this training. It is *highly* recommended that the boy be First Class or higher. The boy needs his Scoutmaster's recommendation to be a Den Chief. Den leaders and Cubmasters are encouraged to attend this training to know how to best use their Den Chiefs.

This half-day training course is intended to prepare Scouts to serve as effective Den Chiefs. You will learn:
