Don't forget this month's Recruiting Incentives! When a currently registered Cub Scout recruits another boy to Cub Scouts, the recruiter will receive a headlamp. When a currently registered Boy Scout, Varsity Scout, Venturing Scout or Explorer Scout recruits another youth to Boy Scouts, Varsity Scouts, Venturing Scouts or Exploring Scouts the recruiter receives a pocket knife. The new member must be new to Scouting and not a transfer from one unit to another within the same program or from one program to another. The registration paperwork and fee must be received at the Council Service Center on or before Sept 30!
