BSA Announces New Adult Leader Registration Policy

The Boy Scouts of America have announced a new policy as it relates to the registration of Adult Leaders in Scouting. Effective June 1, 2010, every adult leader registration must be accompanied by a copy of that person's Youth Protection Training course certificate. The certificate is presented at the end of the training whether it's done online or in a group setting. Youth Protection training is valid for two years and must be renewed in order for the adult leader to be current with their Scout unit. Please distribute this message to all of the leaders and families within your unit.
