## **Congratulation on your election to the Order of the Arrow**

### **New Members (Ordeal Candidate) and Parents**

You may take great pride in being elected, but you are only a candidate for membership in the Order of the Arrow. Few greater thrills await you than become a member of the Order and receive your Arrow sash which happens when you complete the Order of the Arrow Ordeal successfully. Both you and your parents probably have many questions concerning your election, induction, and participation in the Order. We hope this can answer some of your concerns, and increase your understanding about what you have been elected to join.

### **Now that I am elected, What's Next?**

Sikhs Mox Lamonti Lodge holds two induction weekends, called Ordeals, each year. If you can't complete your Ordeal during one of these opportunities in the next year, you will need to be re-elected by your Troop, in order to be inducted. The Ordeal dates for 2011 are:

March 16-18, 2012 - Spring Ordeal at Fire Mountain

June 15-17, 2012 - Summer Ordeal at Camp Black Mountain

October 19-21, 2012 – Fall Ordeal at Fire Mountain

The Ordeal is an induction process based the principles of Brotherhood, Cheerfulness and Service. It is a 24 hour process that asks the candidate to reflect on their accomplishments, complete service and look to the future. As with all Boy Scout events, task asked of the candidates are conducted within the guidance of the Scout Oath and Law, no hazing of any kind is allowed, nor are any religious beliefs or principles violated. Activities are supervised by adult advisers at all times. Transportation is the responsibility of the candidate. As a candidate, you will need to arrive at camp on Friday evening, check in (Ordeal Registration) is between 6-8 PM; plan on eating before arriving but we do have a Cracker Barrel to start the evening off. You should decide which Ordeal you will be attending and complete the official preregistration form .

PLEASE NOTE: Your Ordeal will be finished at 9PM on Saturday night. There is program up to 9PM so please plan on participating fully. You worked to hard during the day to not get all the information that will be provided. Many members do stay over on Saturday night and share an evening of fellowship. A continental breakfast will be served in the morning for those that choose to stay over. Plan on leaving by noon on Sunday

### **What do I need to bring:**

- Official BSA Health Form - signed and filled out and any medications you need with dosage instructions.
- Backpack with personal camping gear. (Please no snacks or electronic gear).
- Sleeping bag, water bottle, your uniform and a tent, a ground cloth, rain gear, work clothes and gloves.
- Bring your Uniform but do not bring your Merit Badge sashes.
- \$40.00 fee (Please prepay fees at the Everett office so we can properly plan for your experience)

Fee includes: OA sash, Lodge flap, Handbook, dues for the current year and meals for the weekend.

There will be a trading post with extra Lodge flaps, patches and memorabilia for sale. If you are interested, you might want to bring a few extra dollars for the trading post.
